CON EDISON CONTEXT

How can we control demand if we take a nuclear facility offline?.....

Is it possible to reduce demand by 100 MW?





Demand Management Program:

Short-term program to *permanently* reduce 100 MW in the commercial/industrial sector



- Who to include in meetings/ emails
- Frequency
- Documentation of communication







Research methods

- Know your sample
- Use of phased data collection methods







Reporting

- Interim reporting opportunities
- Summative reporting can be a documentation tool
 - documents program changes
 - documents implementation of recommendations







CONCLUSIONS & RECOMMENDATIONS

Communication

- Develop a collaborative relationship between evaluators and implementers
- Hold frequent communications
- Use meeting notes to document program changes

Data collection

- Phase data collection
- Phase participant samples

Reporting

- Provide interim reporting for implementers
- Use summative report as a documentation tool
